Advance reservation is required. Most classes have limited registration. Walk-in students will not be accepted. Payment is due prior to class, unless otherwise noted.

Confirmation

A registration confirmation with program details will be sent to you by mail or e-mail.

Cancellations and Refunds

If after you've registered you need to cancel, please notify the contact on your registration confirmation as soon as possible.

For cancellations 5 or more business days prior to the class, a full refund (minus a \$5 processing fee) will be issued.

Refunds cannot be issued for cancellations less than 5 business days or missed classes.

Many programs will allow you to send an alternate participant if you are unable to attend. Please check with the contact on your registration confirmation.

For SNR overnight program refunds, cancellations must be made at least 2 weeks prior to the program.

In the event that the SNR, EWC, BH, and Garden must cancel a class, you will be notified and receive a full refund.
